



Legislative Committee

Eligibility

Legislative Committee members must be current members of the Montana Nursery & Landscape Association and demonstrate an interest in committee activities by attending meetings. The Legislative Committee chair is appointed by the MNLA board of directors. All MNLA board members are eligible to serve, without appointment, as ex officio committee members.

Term

The MNLA President serves as committee chair.

Description

With the executive director, the MNLA Legislative Committee, monitors pertinent state regulatory and legislative activities, maintains contact with Montana Department of Agriculture and coordinates legislative activities as needed. When needed, members of the Legislative Committee, respond to issues under the guidance of the MNLA board of directors.

Chair Responsibilities

The committee chair coordinates grassroots response to relevant issues by MNLA members. He/she leads discussion at the committee meeting in January.
